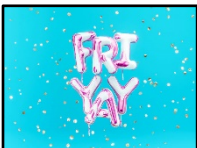


## September 2021 Opportunities for Involvement



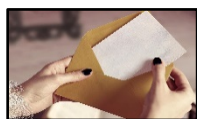

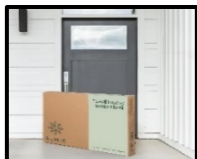
